



Advantage Membership FAQ's

How does the membership work?

Your membership dues are charged monthly (\$8.50+tax/fees + one-time joiners fee of \$49+tax/fees). With this you are granted unlimited golf privileges with the only requirement that you pay a single person cart fee prior to each round (18 or 9) played.

When is the monthly billing?

Monthly dues are automatically charged to your payment media on file the first day of each month. Initial first month payments are not pro-rated and cover the calendar month in which you registered.

How often can I play?

This is an unlimited membership. Members in good standing play as often as they like, weekdays or weekends.

What if I'd like to walk and not use a cart?

The cart fee for each round is mandatory. Players can opt to walk but must still pay the per round fee.

Do I need to share a cart?

Yes, whenever necessary. Each cart holds two players, and the fees we charge are per player.

Will I get paired up with other golfers?

In most cases, yes. Be prepared to play with other golfers. In order for us to offer this membership, we must be efficient and place four players on each tee time.

I'm new to the program, how do I get my membership card?

When you come out for your first round, let the pro shop know you need to pick up a membership card.

Are there any other benefits with the membership?

We provide a driving range, practice green, pro shop, and bar/grill. Purchases in these areas are additional.

Can I bring my own alcohol?

No. It is a violation of state law to bring alcohol on-site of a business with a liquor license. All alcohol consumed must be purchased from Clifton Hollow GC. Violation will result in suspension or cancellation of membership.

How far in advance can I make tee times?

Seven days. We encourage members to book online whenever possible.

Can I cancel my membership?

In the event this program isn't for you, you can cancel your membership with 30 days advance notice in writing. To opt back into the program after cancellation will require payment of the joiners fee.
